Work Location: Copper Mountain Loop

Activities: non-motorized trail maintenance using trail building hand tools.

This is a physical activity requiring certain health and safety considerations. Please be aware of your personal physical condition, wear appropriate attire, such as long sleeves and hat if you are sun sensitive, gloves and sturdy footwear.

Bring sun screen, your own soft or sports drinks. We will provide bottled water and lunch.

Tools to be used: Pulaski, McLeod, pick mattock, limb lopper, and pruning saw. Tools will be provided, but you are welcome to bring your own if they are marked for easy identification.

Directions: From Interstate 17, either direction; take exit 262 (Hwy 69) toward Prescott, AZ. Continue north on Hwy 69 approximately 4.3 miles to the Big Bug Trailhead on the left (west) side of the road. We will meet in the parking area and carpool closer to the worksite.

If you are traveling south on Hwy 69, the trailhead will be on your right (west) just beyond Old Sycamore Rd.

Note: We will not work if it is raining.
